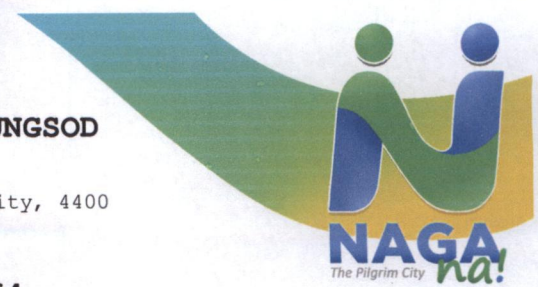

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ALL CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSO) OPERATING IN THE CITY OF NAGA TO COORDINATE WITH THE JESSE M. ROBREDO CENTER FOR GOOD GOVERNANCE (JMRCGG) FOR THE INVENTORY AND DRAFTING OF THE CITY-WIDE CSO DIRECTORY:-

WHEREAS, Article 62, Rule XIII of the Implementing Rules of R.A. 7160 mandates local government units to promote the establishment and operation of people's organizations, non-governmental organizations, and the private sector, to make them active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy, and to directly involve them in the plans, programs, projects or activities of the local government unit, such as, but not limited to, membership in local special bodies (LSBs) and involvement in the delivery of basic services and facilities;

WHEREAS, the DILG issued Memorandum Circular 2019-72 which provide the guidelines in the accreditation of CSOs. Accordingly, all LGUs shall conduct an inventory to generate or update their existing Directory of CSOs. The final updated directory shall serve as the source document for the issuance of Notices of Call for accreditation;

WHEREAS, the JMRCGG, as provided in City Ordinance 2015-055, shall serve as a mechanism for knowledge-sharing geared towards the strengthening of capacities for good local governance; and secure the gains in good governance already achieved by the City of Naga;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance 1995-092 declares the City Government of Naga open to partnerships with Civil Society Organizations in the conception, implementation and evaluation of all government activities and functions;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Naga realizes the urgency of improving efforts to enhance the awareness and understanding of CSOs on the importance of civil society participation, and to increase their capacity to effectively engage in local governance.
